Mrs. LeFlem updated the committee that the disbursements were \$68.75 to NH PTA, \$99.00 to MyPTEZ accountingPTA software yearly fee and \$50.00 for the Henniker Chamber of Commerce yearly payment.

- The Gaga Ball Pits- They have arrived and are a success!
- Charleston Wrap Fundraiser 2020- The PTA typically does one large fundraiser each year. The committee chose the Charleston Wrap Fundraiser this year. The fundraiser was kicked off a week ago Friday and as of now there are 77 students that have created an account and of that 39 students are participating. There have been 269 items sold which total \$4,321 of which the PTA's portion is \$1,628.10. Emily will send an email to further promote the fundraiser and provide more information regarding the student prizes. It was discussed that the PTA looks to earn approximately \$5,000 at the one large fundraiser.
- Bank Signer- Lindsay Nye is currently the second signer on the account.
- Donations- The PTA can now easily accept donations through the website HennikerPTA.org. There is a small processing fee through paypal. Lindsay Thompkins mentioned Giving Tuesday be promoted to encourage donations.
- Membership Dues- Committee discussed moving membership dues to \$10.00.
- PTO Conversion- Emily LeFlem decided to look into more PTA resources. There are grant funded programs available. Committee discussed that being part of the PTA does have value.

New Business

Tree Lighting- The tree lighting was discussed. The tree lighting will occur on December 5th from 5:00pm-6:00pm. The committee discussed that this will be a drive through event. donations and a large 'mailbox" to collect letters to Santa. The committee graciously accepted her offer. The committee discussed having the students make ornaments to hang on the tree and have the ornaments showcased in multiple posts on Facebook. It was suggested that the Henniker Huskie mascot be out waving with Santa.
